
Receptionist: Must be a committed Christian, demonstrating a personal relationship with Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.

Much rejoicing has been going on at Sav-A-Life of Dale County. There has certainly been much noise as those coins were spilled from bottles onto desktops for counting and rolling. Thank you for so graciously returning baby bottles filled with coins, bills and checks. There were a total of 1,050 bottles distributed to 30 churches and one organization this year with 800 being returned so far.

If you have not turned in your bottles, it is never too late. Or if you need someone to drop by and pick up additional bottles, just let us know. To date, \$11,507.30 has been received, with one church still to complete their campaign, and another promise for later in the year. Thank you all!
