Walk for Life - "I have written your name on the palms of my hands..."

Isaiah 49:16

Our Walk for Life theme this year is taken from Isaiah 49:16, *"I have written your name on the palms of my hands, your walls are continually before me."* Wow, God himself has noted me in the palm of His hand. Have you ever needed to make a note of a phone number or some reminder and without any paper, written it in the palm of your hand so you won't forget? I have, and God has too!

Although this was written for Jerusalem, we are all His now (according to Romans). So this verse is for me and you! God says I will not forget you. I have carved you on the palm of My hand. I have called you by your name. You are mine. You are precious to me and I love you.

This verse tells us that our damage and hurt (the ruined walls of some of his children) is always in His mind and He loves us SO MUCH that He has written our name on His hand. That is how much we mean to Him. He is saying He cannot forget us, we are always right there.



This ministry is a life affirming ministry. And sometimes that means helping someone who is hurting - life has thrown them many curves and they are very fragile. A new baby in the mix is just too difficult to think about. But, if we can place before them the thought that God loves them so much that He has *"written their name on the palms of His hands,"* that God is personal, not indifferent or far away, but close and near and here and right with us and for us and His love is everlasting, it can and does make a difference.

The verse just above in Isaiah 49:15 says, *"Can a woman forget her suckling child, that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb? Yes, they may forget, yet I will not forget you."* As hard as it may be for you to imagine forgetting one's child, it CAN happen. Some mothers do. That is their life, and we are not to judge or condemn. But God is not like that. His love is everlasting. His love is constant. When all else fails and fades, He is there. He is secure. Always. His love and mercy are forever.
